

D-SAACP Continuing Education Information

This handout is intended for use by personnel who are applying for D-SAACP renewal and provides resources to complete the continuing education requirement for Navy SAPR personnel. Applicants are responsible for completing their requirements in a timely manner that meets the D-SAACP submission deadlines specific to their certification. Applicants must openly communicate with their supervising SARC to track completed hours in DSAID. Please note that not all professional development courses may qualify for D-SAACP continuing education. SAPR Victim Advocates <u>must</u> consult with their SARC to confirm if specific trainings are appropriate for their role and approved, based on the subject matter and content. SARCs <u>must</u> use the guidelines in DoDI 6493.03 when approving trainings for D-SAACP continuing education credit.

All Navy SAPR applicants must complete **32 hours** of continuing education:

2 Hours of Victim Advocacy Ethics Training:

CNIC HQ SAPR's previous guidance has been that all Navy SAPR personnel must complete the "Navy SAPR Professional Code of Ethics Training" provided by CNIC to fulfil the D-SAACP 2 hours of ethics requirement. While CNIC HQ SAPR continues to review all trainings for compliance, including the Navy SAPR Professional Code of Ethics Training, Navy SAPR personnel may use the below trainings to fulfill the ethics requirement. Once the Navy SAPR Processional Code of Ethics Training has been cleared for use, this guidance will be updated and the additional ethics courses will not be

Additional Information and Reminders:

- Applicants must seek training in emerging issues related to victim-focused and trauma-informed victim advocacy and care.
- Continuing education must be related to sexual assault prevention and response and other cross-cutting topical areas for building victim advocacy skills.
- No more than 12 hours can be from peripheral topics (such as suicide prevention). Although these topics are important, most CEUs should be more closely related to victim advocacy.
- Applicants renewing for a second time or more cannot repeat CEUs from within the same certification renewal period.
- SARCs must refer to *DODI 6495.03* for guidance as well as information on SAPR.mil.

The Washington Coalition of Sexual Assault Programs offers a 1-hour online Ethics of Confidentiality.

- A minimum of 8 hours must be from in-person trainings. "In-person" training requirements may be met by attending live webinars but not by watching recordings.
