

Wallops Island



Q Is Wallops Island isolated?

A No, although located in a rural area, Wallops Island is not isolated. The local area provides all the amenities as larger areas; just a bit spread out.

Q Where will my children go to school?

A There are multiple schools in the area, and your child will attend the school designated for them based on your address. If you live in Navy Housing, you may choose which school they attend. Most housing residents opt for schools on Chincoteague.

Q Is the Navy Housing PPV?

A No, the housing at Wallops Island is still traditionally Navy-owned housing. Your BAH will be stopped if you accept an assignment to a housing unit.

Q How far is the base from Navy Housing?

A Housing units are located outside the fence, just a short walk to the main Navy facility.

Q Does the area have Public Transportation?

A There is no Public Transportation in the local area.



Q Are pets allowed in Navy Housing?

A Local policy allows for two domestic pets. There are currently no breed restrictions for dogs.

Q If I choose to live in the community, are there sufficient rental properties available?

A The current inventory of community rental property is extremely limited. The Housing Service Center can assist you in finding suitable and affordable housing within the area.

Q Does Wallops have temporary furnishings available?

A We do not have the capabilities to provide temporary furnishings.

Q I'm planning on being a Geographical Bachelor. Are quarters available?

A No, Wallops does not provide quarters for Geo Bachelors; you would need to find accommodations in the community at your cost.
