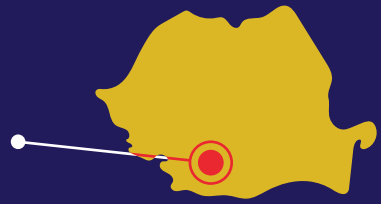

Deveselu, Romania



Q Can my family or dependents PCS with me?

A No. Deveselu is a dependent restricted tour for the military and civilians. Therefore, dependents are not allowed to accompany the sponsor.

Q What type of electrical service is used?

A The electrical outlets in Romania are 230V. You will need a downward transformer to accommodate U.S. electronics, i.e., irons, microwaves, etc.

Q What is housing like in the surrounding community?

A Many apartments have up to three bedrooms, and few houses have four bedrooms. Most landlords discourage pets, more specifically dogs.

Q Do homes have central heat and air conditioning (HVAC)?

A Yes, houses and apartments both have HVAC.

Q If I have too much furniture, will the government store it for me?

A No, it is not recommended. If you bring most of your furniture, it would be your responsibility to locate storage if there is any available. Your sponsor should inform you of how much furniture and what types to ship because most houses and apartments are already furnished.

Q Should I bring my own major appliances?

A No, this is not recommended. Property managers will provide a stove, refrigerator, microwave, washer, and dryer for the duration of your tour. Typically, these item types in off-base units are equipped with major appliances.

Q How can I find housing in the community if I don't speak the language?

A The HSC's counselors are bilingual, and they will serve as a translator and provide a list of properties that are vacant and available in the community. Most property owners/managers usually speak English as well.
